## **Primary School Visits**

In late May and early June, we plan to meet with primary school staff to discuss students and to visit your child in their primary school and hand over a welcome information pack.

## **Friendship form**

In May we will be emailing a microsoft form to parents asking them to name a couple of friends their child may wish to be placed with. We will do our best to ensure new students know someone in their form but we cannot guarantee this in every single circumstance. Please note, in Year 7 they are taught in tutor groups for some lessons but for many lessons such as English, Maths, PE and PHSE the students are completely mixed across all tutor groups.

## **Student Tutor Group, House and Site Allocation emailed to parents – Friday 13<sup>th</sup> June**

After we have collected information from parents and primary schools we will allocate Tutor Groups, Houses and sites to our incoming Year 7 students, ensuring an even split of gender, abilities and primary schools. We start this process by allocating children with older siblings to the same site as their sibling and then look at keeping friendship groups together where we can and by the time we do this we have thousands of pieces of data to consider. We are proud to be one school based across two sites. The curriculum, expectations and opportunities are the same and students can travel across sites after school to access facilities and opportunities.

## **Parents Induction Evening:**

**Waterleat Road Site – Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> June / Borough Road Site - Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> June**

We will welcome you into the Academy for parent's information evening and uniform sizing on **Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> June for students attending the Waterleat Road Site** and **Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> June for students attending the Borough Road Site**. This will be an opportunity for you to meet key staff including, tutors, house teams and the senior leadership team. The evening is aimed at parents but children are welcome to attend as well.

## **Deadline date for ordering your child's uniform, so it arrives in time for September is Friday 15<sup>th</sup> August 2025**

## **Induction Days - Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> & Friday 4<sup>th</sup> July (8:20am – 2:45pm)**

We will hold two induction days for all Year 6 students on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> and Friday 4<sup>th</sup> July. Students will not attend their primary school but are to arrive straight at the Academy on the site they have been allocated. Students will experience two full days of typical lessons, being inducted into the Academy, making clear our expectations whilst having a chance to find their way around in advance of September and hopefully forming some new friendships. We are hopeful that after the two days, students leave feeling enthused and confident about starting in September.

## **Transition week (Summer School) Monday 11<sup>th</sup> August – Friday 15<sup>th</sup> August (8:30am – 3pm)**

For the third year in a row will be holding another highly successful one-week optional Transition week in the summer holidays, led by a specialist external company the Big Step, to support students to make new friends, develop their confidence and grow their self-esteem. Last year 160 students took part in our transition week and it was hugely successful. This Year we plan to host the transition week on both sites, so the children will spend all week on the site they have been allocated. The Big Step are running transition programmes in many schools across Devon and the cost is £125 for the week, this cost can be paid via instalments.
